History of the AIHS

The Amesbury Academy was founded in 2001 by a group of teachers and administrators who felt there was a need to provide an alternative school to students who were not succeeding in a traditional high school setting. They developed the Amesbury Academy as a learning environment that was based on individual student success, regardless of personal or academic struggles. With this *whole student* approach, the staff has seen students overcome great challenges to earn their diploma.
