AES Principal Search Committee

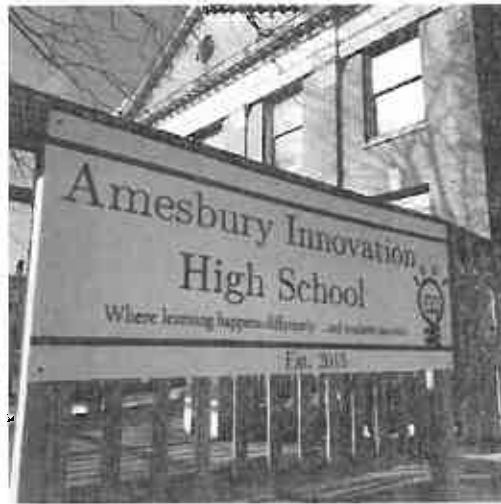
