SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- 1. On the generic application fill out everything except the name of the scholarship and your signature.
- 2. Take it somewhere to get it copied. The staff in the main office and guidance **MAY NOT** copy it for you. It is **YOUR** responsibility. This includes Mrs. Wile and Mrs. Fusco.
- 3. Once everything is copied fill in the name of the scholarship and sign your name. PLEASE MAKE THEM ALL ORIGINAL SIGNATURES.
- 4. Unless specified they are to be put together in this way:
- 5. Application, Your Letter, Resume and Teacher Recommendation stapled at the top left hand corner.
- 6. For the **LIONS** and **ROTARY** Fill only one application for the Lions and one application for the Rotary Scholarship. This puts you in the running for all of them. On your letter put Dear Rotary Scholarship Committee or Dear Lions Club Scholarship Committee.
- 7. By you signing all of your scholarship applications, it gives the Guidance Center permission to attach a transcript to each application that requires it.
- 8. You must use the check list that is attached to the packet. You must place a check mark next to each scholarship that you are turning in. When turning in the applications and list, you must sit with Mrs. Bixby or a guidance counselor so that each application can be verified.

A business format should be followed.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION TIPS

FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS by completing all requirements and observing all deadlines. Be early if possible. Remember, this will be your only way to present yourself to the scholarship committees.

Make sure that the application is **NEATLY DONE**.

In answering all questions, **BE YOURSELF** and don't answer the questions the way you think we want them answered. Do, however, remember that you are applying for a substantial amount of money, therefore slang, abbreviations and crude language does not belong in any part of the application.

The required **LETTER** should be typed. Read over your letter first for grammar and spelling (use spell/grammar check) and have someone else read it for you. Please do not make your letter more than 250 words.

You are **RESPONSIBLE** for copying each application, letter, resume and teacher recommendations. You must staple your application, letter, resume and teacher applications for each scholarship. The Guidance Staff and the Office Staff **CAN NOT** copy your scholarship information.

ANY OR ALL COMPLETED SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS IN THE PACKET ARE DUE IN THE AMESBURY HIGH SCHOOL GUIDANCE CENTER NO LATER THAN MARCH 9, 2012 AT NOONTIME.
