- I. Call to Order/Mission Statement/Pledge of Allegiance (0:14) Mayor Gove called the meeting to order. Ms. Welch read the mission statement and led the committee in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- II. Comments by Visitors & Delegations (2:00)
 - Steve Stanganelli 12 Amidon Ave Mr. Stanganelli spoke about adopting a bus safety program as the city of Peabody had done, he also discussed an upcoming city council meeting with Whittier Tech.
- III. Communications & Reports
 - A. Educational Leadership (6:20)
 - 1. AMS Field Trip presentation Mr. Denio presented to the committee on the planned AMS field trip to Boston including specifics on schedules, cost/fundraising, and criteria for attending. At the conclusion of the presentation Mr. Denio answered questions posed by the committee.
 - 2. School Improvement Plans Superintendent McAndrews began the presentation by stating the plans were two-year plans and the principals would sharing their strategic objectives and how the plans tied to the strategic plan.
