## PERSONAL FINANCE CP. CLASSROOM POLICIES

This course is one quarter long and will include discussion, activities, and exercises regarding many personal finance topics including: daily money management (monthly bills, check register, etc.), credit and debt, insurance, saving & investments, and taxes. There will be group and individual work.

**Required Materials:** You must bring **ALL** of the following to class **EVERY DAY**:

- 1. **Composition notebook** Standard black bound book will stay in class.
- 2. 3-Ring, Loose-leaf Notebook or sturdy folder for PERSONAL FINANCE ONLY
- 3. Notebook Paper in your notebook or folder
- 4. **Pen and Pencil** are required; pencil is <u>highly recommended</u> for daily assignments. Pen is necessary for completing tax forms and for writing checks.

If you cannot afford any of the above items, please see me and I will assist you in obtaining them.

## GRADING...

(50%) Portfolio / Assignments / Journal Writing: Many smaller and larger activities will be added to a portfolio that will be assessed. Daily assignments will be done in your composition notebook. Journal writing will occur frequently—the prompt must be copied and all entries dated in order to receive credit.

(30%) Quizzes: See me to arrange a time to make up a missed quiz. Unexcused absences result in a zero.

(20%) Class Participation & Class Responsibility: This will often "round up" or "round down" your overall grade. Participation is crucial by making suggestions, offering well-reasoned opinions and unique thoughts related to the topic, interacting respectfully and helpfully with peers and myself. This will ideally make the course much better, more interesting, and more worthwhile for every student.

It is also extremely important to be responsible & respectful:

- Arrive on time, with ALL necessary materials, prepared to learn.
- Be responsible for your own learning: If you have questions or are confused, ask for help!
- Be respectful of your peers and of myself.

EMAIL(S) (clearly, please):

- Contribute to the class by asking questions, explaining concepts, and being cooperative.
- No use of headphones, cell phones, texting, or other similar technology.

**Extra Help:** See me A-block or after school. Please let me know at least one day in advance. Also, tutoring is often available through Mu Alpha Theta, the mathematics honor society--see an advisor.

<u>Academic Dishonesty</u>: Academic dishonesty will not be tolerated in any instance. When cheating, plagiarism, copying, or sharing of the same materials is detected, a zero will be entered in the teacher's gradebook for the assignment, quiz, test, paper, etc. In addition:
